


Ukraine as a contracting party to the Convention on a common transit procedure



On October 1, 2022, Ukraine became the 36th contracting party to the Convention on a common transit procedure and started the international application of NCTS Phase 4


No. of <u>closed (MWO/GRL)</u> common transit movements with UA in October-November 2022

Pillars of common transit implementation



For the national application of NCTS

- Law of Ukraine on a common transit procedure No. 78 adopted in 2019
- 3 resolutions of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine
- 5 orders of the Ministry of Finance of Ukraine
- 2 orders of the State Customs Service of Ukraine

IT solution for NCTS Phase 4 was received by Ukraine from Customs Administration of Lithuania in December 2019 and deployed in 2020 after localization


Department on Implementation of International Transit System established in March 2021

Dedicated IT experts (internal and external)

Helpdesk launched in March 2021

National Transit Coordinator defined

Success of the project always depends on the <u>TEAM</u>



In case of Ukraine, commitment of all bodies at all levels to join the Convention on a common transit procedure allowed to finalize all formal procedures for joining Convention in 5 days including voting relevant laws in the Parliament and signing them by the President in 1 day

CORE TEAM

Ministry of Finance of Ukraine (including its RST) – legislation and strategic coordination of the project

State Customs Service of Ukraine – practical project implementation, coordination of common transit application, internal and external users support (NCTS helpdesk), communication with DG TAXUD and business

EU4PFM – foreign and national experts and financial support of the project

DG TAXUD as a partner and a guide

Preconditions for the accession to the Convention on a common transit procedure for Ukraine


Application of NCTS Phase 4 at the national level at least during 1 year

Successful Conformance Testing Modes 1, 2 and 3 (international one)


Confirmation of legislation, technical and organizational readiness to join the Convention during monitoring missions

Preparation and progress on NCTS Phase 5 development


